



All Cosmetic Tattooing Procedures General Rules & Aftercare

Eyebrow, Eyeliner & Lip Cosmetic Tattooing

If your aftercare is not followed correctly, Designing Faces will take no responsibility & it will be at the discretion of the Cosmetic Tattoo Technician if we will be able to continue to work on the area in the future. Please understand that this is an investment in your face & the aftercare is the most critically important part of the procedure.

- Keep area completely dry & product free for a minimum of 10 days. Exception to this rule is to apply a light layer of Bepanthen antiseptic cream the following day after procedure, once a day for 5 days.
- We recommend using micellar water cleanser to cleanse face with make up wipes during healing process. We recommend using a straw to drink & be very careful when eating food that you do not rub the food on your lips.
- No exercise for 10 days after your procedure or the day of procedure¹. Your eyebrows will fade very fast due to the production of salt/sweat. Salt is actually what is used to remove semi-permanent makeup.
- YOU CANNOT HAVE A TAN 30 DAYS BEFORE & ABSOLUTELY NO SUN 30 DAYS AFTER. Hat & glasses must be on at all times in the sun & avoid sun/heat for 30 days after your procedure. If you resume tanning within 30 days, the results will fade quickly, heal darker, fade super fast or not retain at all. As tanned skin bleeds easier and heals poorly and colours will not heal properly. Designing Faces will cancel your appointment if you show up with a tan. DO NOT have a tan/sunburn on your face prior to your procedure as the tan will exfoliate taking colour with it as it fades. If you show up to your appointment with a tan or sunburnt, you will be required to reschedule and your deposit will be forfeited. The determination if you are too tan will be at Designing Faces discretion.
- It is recommended to apply the Vaseline to the treated area/s prior to swimming after healing time to prevent the chlorine water/salt water from penetrating the area.
- Botox or fillers may still be performed in or near the area at least 2 week before treatment however we do advise this to be done after cosmetic tattooing in case of muscle movement in shape change.
- Avoid touching the treated areas during the healing process. DO NOT RUB, SCRATCH, PLUCK OR PICK AT THE TREATED AREA. Let any scabbing, flaking or dry skin naturally exfoliate off. Picking can cause scarring or infection.
- Cosmetic Lip Tattoo treatment can activate herpes simplex virus (coldsore) if you have had a coldsore previously therefore we require you to medicate to prevent any virus or coldsore occurring. The required medication is VALTREX with dosage of 1000mg daily 3 days before your treatment & 4 days after treatment. You can obtain this prescription from your GP. Please ensure you receive a prescription with a repeat so you can medicate for your touch up appointment. Please note: coldsores/virus may still occur even with the medication being taken.
- Even after healing, do not put any product containing active cosmetic ingredients to prevent fading inclusive of lactic peels & glycolic exfoliation
- Please remember that the same rules apply to any touchup or refreshment appointment

Reminder:

Touch up appointments must be booked within the first 3 months or a procedure fee will occur. Both top & bottom eyeliner must be done together no separate bookings will be made. Appointments will not be moved earlier if you have premature fading due to lifestyle. Designing Faces reserves the right to refuse future services if we believe the results won't be to the client's satisfaction.

There are no guarantees as to the final outcome - Your skin, lifestyle and after care play a huge role in YOUR results. EVERYONE heals differently.

There may be other contraindications not listed and your appointment may be cancelled at Designing Faces' discretion if we believe it is unsafe or you will not achieve the results you desire. Semi permanent makeup is an art. Client's results will vary and using a pencil or powder may still be needed.

Remember, no two sides of the face are the same.

Perfection is our goal, but, note that nothing is PERFECT. Eyebrows are sisters, NOT twins!

Deposit & Booking Policy:

Everyone can appreciate how valued time is therefore, our scheduling is very structured. Our schedule is constantly quite full therefore it is up to the client to maintain their current and future appointments.

A **\$100.00** non-refundable deposit is required in order to reserve your appointment time upon scheduling. The deposit will be credited toward the procedure fees. If the deposit is not received within 24 hours of booking, your appointment may be forfeited without any notice.

Cancellation/No show Policy:

A 48 hours cancellation notice is required to cancel/reschedule an appointment. If you fail to cancel your appointment within the 48 hrs, your deposit will be forfeited & FULL payment will be required to reschedule. Any client that does NOT show for a scheduled appointment, will forfeit their deposit.

Rescheduling/Late Policy:

To avoid unfair delays to clients, if you are more than 15 minutes late to your appointment it will be necessary to reschedule.

Touch appointments/ Refreshments:

Touch up appointments must be booked within the first 3 months or a procedure fee will occur. Appointments will not be moved earlier if you have premature fading due to lifestyle. They will appear more powdered or blurred under the skin as well. Designing Faces reserves the right to refuse future services if we believe the results won't be to the client's satisfaction.
